| Public Law 103-414 | To amend title 18, United States Code, to make clear a telecommunications carrier's duty to cooperate in the interception of communications for law enforcement purposes, and for other purposes. "Communications Assistance for Law Enforcement Act". (H.R. 4922) (Approved October 25, 1994; effective dates vary). |
| Public Law 103-416 | To amend title III of the Immigration and Nationality Act to make changes in the laws relating to nationality and naturalization. "Immigration and Nationality Technical Corrections Act of 1994". (H.R. 783) (Approved October 25, 1994; effective dates vary). |
| Public Law 103-419 | To amend the United States Commission on Civil Rights Act of 1983. "Civil Rights Commission Amendments Act of 1994". (S. 2372) (Approved October 25, 1994). |

| Public Law 103-438 | To facilitate obtaining foreign-located antitrust evidence by authorizing the Attorney General of the United States and the Federal Trade Commission to provide, in accordance with antitrust mutual assistance agreements, antitrust evidence to foreign antitrust authorities on a reciprocal basis; and for other purposes. "International Antitrust Enforcement Assistance Act of 1994". (H.R. 4781) (Approved November 2, 1994). |

| Public Law 103-465 | To approve and implement the trade agreements concluded in the Uruguay Round of multilateral trade negotiations. "Uruguay Round Agreements Act". "Retirement Protection Act of 1994". (H.R. 5110) (Approved December 8, 1994; effective dates vary). |
