### S. Con. Res. 21

Mar. 30, 1993

MS. MOSELEY-BRAUN, FOR HERSELF, MR. HATCH, MR. MCCAIN, MR. DOMENICI, MR. DECONCINI, MRS. BOXER, MR. BURNS, MR. REID, AND MR. CONRAD

Expressing the sense of the Congress that expert testimony concerning the nature and effect of domestic violence, including descriptions of the experiences of battered women, should be admissible if offered in a State court by a defendant in a criminal case.

Mar. 30, 1993—Referred to the Senate Committee on the Judiciary.

Oct. 8, 1994—Senate Committee on the Judiciary discharged from further consideration.

Oct. 8, 1994—Agreed to by the Senate.

Nov. 29, 1994—Referred to the House Committee on the Judiciary.
