

## LEGISLATION IN OR THROUGH CONFERENCE

- H.R. 1119** (*S. 936*)—To authorize appropriations for fiscal year 1998 for military activities of the Department of Defense, for military construction, and for defense activities of the Department of Energy, to prescribe personnel strengths for such fiscal year for the Armed Forces, and for other purposes. “National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 1998”. The Senate requested a conference July 11, 1997, and appointed conferees. The House agreed to a conference July 25, 1997, and appointed conferees (including from the Committee on the Judiciary). Conference report filed in the House October 23, 1997 (**H.Rept. 105-340**). The House agreed to the conference report October 28, 1997 (*286 yeas; 123 nays*). The Senate considered the conference report October 31, 1997. The Senate agreed to the conference report November 6, 1997 (*90 yeas; 10 nays*).
- H.R. 2281** (*S. 2037*)—To amend title 17, United States Code, to implement the World Intellectual Property Organization Copyright Treaty and Performances and Phonograms Treaty. “WIPO Copyright Treaties Implementation Act”. The Senate requested a conference September 17, 1998, and appointed conferees. The House agreed to a conference September 23, 1998, and appointed conferees. Conference report filed in the House in the House October 8, 1998 (**H.Rept. 105-796**). The Senate agreed to the conference report October 8, 1998. The House agreed to the conference report October 12, 1998.
- H.R. 3150** (*S. 1301*)—To amend title 11 of the United States Code, and for other purposes. “Bankruptcy Reform Act of 1998”. The Senate requested a conference September 23, 1998, and appointed conferees. The House agreed to a conference September 28, 1998, and appointed conferees. Conference report filed in the House October 7, 1998 (**H.Rept. 105-794**). The House agreed to the conference report October 9 (legislative day of October 8), 1998. (*300 yeas; 125 nays*).
- H.R. 3616** (*S. 2057*)—To authorize appropriations for fiscal year 1999 for military activities of the Department of Defense, for military construction, and for defense activities of the Department of Energy, to prescribe personnel strengths for such fiscal year for the Armed Forces, and for other purposes. “National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 1999”. The Senate requested a conference June 25, 1998, and appointed conferees. The House agreed to a conference July 22, 1998, and appointed conferees (including from the Committee on the Judiciary). Conference report filed in the House September 22, 1998 (**H.Rept. 105-736**). The House agreed to the conference report September 24, 1998 (*373 yeas; 50 nays*). The Senate considered the conference report September 30, 1998. The Senate agreed to the conference report October 1, 1998 (*96 yeas; 2 nays*).
- S. 2073** (*H.R. 3/H.R. 1818*)—To amend the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act of 1974 to authorize appropriations for fiscal years 1999, 2000, 2001, and 2002, and for other purposes. The House requested a conference October 1, 1998, and appointed conferees.
