

LEGISLATION PENDING BEFORE THE FULL COMMITTEE*

- H.R. 2276**—To amend the Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996 to extend the deadline for aliens to present a border crossing card that contains a biometric identifier matching the appropriate biometric characteristics of the alien. Ordered reported by the Subcommittee on Immigration and Claims June 27, 2001.
- H.R. 2526**—To make permanent the moratorium enacted by the Internet Tax Freedom Act, and for other purposes. “Internet Tax Fairness Act of 2001”. Ordered reported, amended, by the Subcommittee on Commercial and Administrative Law July 16, 2002.
- H.R. 4043**—To bar Federal agencies from accepting for any identification-related purpose and State-issued driver’s license, or other comparable identification document, unless the State requires licenses or comparable documents issued to nonimmigrant aliens to expire upon the expiration of the aliens’ nonimmigrant visas, and for other purposes. Ordered reported by the Subcommittee on Immigration and Claims May 2, 2002.
- H.R. 4597**—To prevent nonimmigrant aliens who are delinquent in child support payments from gaining entry into the United States. Ordered reported by the Subcommittee on Immigration and Claims May 2, 2002.

SUPERSEDED LEGISLATION

- H.R. 2623**—To extend the deadline for granting posthumous citizenship to individuals who die while on active-duty service in the Armed Forces. Ordered reported by the Subcommittee on Immigration and Claims April 17, 2002. (*Superseded by H.R. 2215*).

FAILED/TABLED LEGISLATION

- H.R. 2120**—To ensure the application of the antitrust laws to local telephone monopolies, and for other purposes. “Broadband Antitrust Restoration and Reform Act”. Failed to be ordered reported, amended, to the House June 13, 2001. (*15 yeas; 19 nays*).
