To prohibit the cloning of humans, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Ban on Human
- 5 Cloning Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION REGARDING CLONING OF HUMANS.
- 7 (a) IN GENERAL.—It shall be unlawful for a person
- 8 to engage in a human cloning procedure with the intent
- 9 of implanting the resulting cellular product into a uterus.
- 10 (b) CLONING PROCEDURE.—A person shall be con-
- 11 sidered to have engaged in a human cloning procedure for
- 12 purposes of subsection (a) if the person transfers the nu-

- 1 cleus of a human somatic cell into an egg cell from which
- 2 the nucleus has been removed.
- 3 (c) Criminal Penalty.—Any person who violates
- 4 subsection (a) shall be fined in accordance with title 18,
- 5 United States Code, or imprisoned not more than 5 years,
- 6 or both.
- 7 (d) Effective Date.—This Act takes effect upon
- 8 the expiration the 30-day period beginning on the date of
- 9 the enactment of this Act.
