- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Death Penalty for Cop
- 5 Killers Act of 2007".
- 6 SEC. 2. DEATH PENALTY FOR KILLING LAW ENFORCEMENT
- 7 OFFICERS.
- 8 Section 3592(c) of title 18, United States Code, is
- 9 amended by inserting after paragraph (16) the following:

1 "(17) KILLING OF LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFI2 CER.—The defendant killed or attempted to kill a
3 person who is authorized by law to engage in or su4 pervise the prevention, detention, investigation, or
5 prosecution of any criminal violation of law; or to ar6 rest or prosecute an individual for any such viola7 tion.".
