**A BILL**

To allow for certiorari review of certain cases denied relief  
or review by the United States Court of Appeals for  
the Armed Forces.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Equal Justice for  
5 United States Military Personnel Act of 2007”.

1 **SEC. 2. CERTIORARI TO THE UNITED STATES COURT OF AP-**  
2 **PEALS FOR THE ARMED FORCES.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1259 of title 28, United  
4 States Code, is amended—

5 (1) in paragraph (3), by inserting “or denied”  
6 after “granted”; and

7 (2) in paragraph (4), by inserting “or denied”  
8 after “granted”.

9 (b) TECHNICAL AND CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—  
10 Section 867a(a) of title 10, United States Code, is amend-  
11 ed by striking “The Supreme Court may not review by  
12 a writ of certiorari under this section any action of the  
13 Court of Appeals for the Armed Forces in refusing to  
14 grant a petition for review.”.
