### **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "American Levee Cer-
- 5 tification Act of 2011".

#### 6 SEC. 2. RURAL COMMUNITY FLOOD PROTECTION.

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—On receipt of a request from a
8 non-Federal interest, the Secretary of the Army (referred
9 to in this section as the "Secretary") shall conduct a levee
10 system evaluation and certification of a federally author-

ized levee or a non-federally authorized levee for purposes
 of the National Flood Insurance Program established
 under chapter 1 of the National Flood Insurance Act of
 1968 (42 U.S.C. 4011 et seq.).

5 (b) REQUIREMENTS.—A levee system evaluation and6 certification under subsection (a) shall—

7 (1) at a minimum, comply with the require8 ments of section 65.10 of title 44, Code of Federal
9 Regulations (as in effect on the date of enactment
10 of this Act); and

(2) be carried out in accordance with such procedures as the Secretary, in consultation with the
Director of the Federal Emergency Management
Agency, may establish.

15 (c) Cost Sharing.—

16 (1) NON-FEDERAL SHARE.—Subject to para17 graph (2), the non-Federal share of the cost of car18 rying out a levee system evaluation and certification
19 under this section shall be 35 percent.

20 (2) ADJUSTMENT.—The Secretary shall adjust
21 the non-Federal share under paragraph (1) to zero
22 if—

23 (A) the non-Federal interest is located in
24 an area with a population of 10,000 or fewer
25 individuals; or

(B) the division of the non-Federal interest with responsibility for the applicable levee is staffed by individuals operating on a volunteer basis.

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
