- 9 (1) by striking the period at the end and insert-
- ing "; and";

1	(2) by striking "mortgagor receiving" and in-
2	serting the following: "mortgagor—
3	"(1) receiving"; and
4	(3) by adding at the end the following:
5	"(2) who applied for a loan, advance, or emer-
6	gency mortgage relief payments under this title on
7	or before September 30, 2011, and was approved to
8	receive the benefit of such loan, advance, or emer-
9	gency mortgage relief on or before December 31,
10	2011.".
