3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Milk Quality Stand-

5 ards Act of 2011".

6 SEC. 2. MAXIMUM SOMATIC CELL COUNT.

7 Chapter IV of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic

- 8 Act (21 U.S.C. 341 et seq.) is amended by adding at the
- 9 end the following:

1 "SEC. 424. MAXIMUM SOMATIC CELL COUNT.

2 "(a) MAXIMUM SOMATIC CELL COUNT.—

3 "(1) IN GENERAL.—The maximum somatic cell
4 count for all dairy products sold, transported, or of5 fered for sale or transport, in interstate commerce
6 shall be 400,000 cells per milliliter of fluid milk, or
7 equivalent, as determined by the Secretary.

8 "(2) ADJUSTMENT.—The Secretary, after con-9 sideration of any recommendations submitted by the 10 National Conference on Interstate Milk Shipments, 11 may lower the maximum somatic cell count estab-12 lished under paragraph (1).

"(b) CALCULATION.—The Secretary shall promulgate
regulations to require that the calculation of a herd average somatic cell count under this section shall be made
using a geometric, rather than an arithmetic, mean.

"(c) REVISION.—The Secretary, in consultation with
the National Conference on Interstate Milk Shipments,
shall revise the Pasteurized Milk Ordinance to take into
account the requirement under subsection (a) and any regulations promulgated under subsection (b).

22 "(d) ENFORCEMENT.—

"(1) IN GENERAL.—Beginning on the date that
is 18 months after the date of enactment of this section, any person that sells, transports, or offers for
sale or transport, in interstate commerce any dairy

product in violation of subsection (a) shall be subject
 to a civil penalty in an amount determined in ac cordance with the regulations promulgated under
 paragraph (2).

5 "(2) REGULATIONS.—Not later than 18 months
6 after the date of enactment of this section, the Sec7 retary shall promulgate regulations establishing a
8 schedule of civil penalties for violations of subsection
9 (a).".

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
