## **JOINT RESOLUTION**

Making continuing appropriations for death gratuities and related survivor benefits for survivors of deceased military service members of the Department of Defense for fiscal year 2014, and for other purposes.

- 1 Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives
- 2 of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 That the following sums are hereby appropriated, out

- 1 of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated,
- 2 for death gratuities and related benefits for survivors of
- 3 deceased military service members of the Department of
- 4 Defense for fiscal year 2014, and for other purposes,
- 5 namely:
- 6 Sec. 101. (a) Such amounts as may be necessary,
- 7 at a rate for operations as provided for fiscal year 2013
- 8 in the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2013
- 9 (division C of Public Law 113–6) and under the authority
- 10 and conditions provided in such Act, for "Operation and
- 11 Maintenance" and "Military Personnel" accounts for con-
- 12 tinuing the following projects and activities that are not
- 13 otherwise specifically provided for in this joint resolution
- 14 or the Pay Our Military Act (Public Law 113-39), and
- 15 for which appropriations, funds, or other authority were
- 16 made available by the Department of Defense Appropria-
- 17 tions Act, 2013:
- 18 (1) The payment of a death gratuity under sec-
- tions 1475–1477 and 1489 of title 10, United States
- 20 Code.
- 21 (2) The payment or reimbursement for funeral
- and burial expenses authorized under sections 1481
- and 1482 of title 10, United States Code.
- 24 (3) The payment or reimbursement of author-
- 25 ized funeral travel and travel related to the dignified

- 1 transfer of remains and unit memorial services
- 2 under section 481f of title 37, United States Code.
- 3 (4) The temporary continuation of a basic al-
- 4 lowance of housing for dependents of members dying
- on active duty, as authorized by section 403(1) of
- 6 title 37, United States Code.
- 7 (b) The rate for operations provided by subsection (a)
- 8 for each program or activity shall be calculated to reflect
- 9 the full amount of any reduction required in fiscal year
- 10 2013 pursuant to—
- 11 (1) any provision of division G of the Consoli-
- dated and Further Continuing Appropriations Act,
- 13 2013 (Public Law 113–6), including section 3004;
- 14 and
- 15 (2) the Presidential sequestration order dated
- March 1, 2013, except as attributable to budget au-
- thority made available by the Disaster Relief Appro-
- priations Act, 2013 (Public Law 113–2).
- 19 Sec. 102. Appropriations made by section 101 shall
- 20 be available to the extent and in the manner that would
- 21 be provided by the pertinent appropriations Act.
- Sec. 103. Unless otherwise provided for in this joint
- 23 resolution or in the applicable appropriations Act for fiscal
- 24 year 2014, appropriations and funds made available and
- 25 authority granted pursuant to this joint resolution shall

- 1 be available until whichever of the following first occurs:
- 2 (1) the enactment into law of an appropriation for any
- 3 project or activity provided for in this joint resolution; (2)
- 4 the enactment into law of the applicable appropriations
- 5 Act for fiscal year 2014 without any provision for such
- 6 project or activity; or (3) December 15, 2013.
- 7 Sec. 104. Expenditures made pursuant to this joint
- 8 resolution shall be charged to the applicable appropriation,
- 9 fund, or authorization whenever a bill in which such appli-
- 10 cable appropriation, fund, or authorization is contained is
- 11 enacted into law.
- 12 Sec. 105. This joint resolution shall be implemented
- 13 so that only the most limited funding action of that per-
- 14 mitted in the joint resolution shall be taken in order to
- 15 provide for continuation of projects and activities.
- 16 Sec. 106. It is the sense of Congress that this joint
- 17 resolution may also be referred to as the "Honoring the
- 18 Families of Fallen Soldiers Act".

- 1 This joint resolution may be cited as the "Depart-
- 2 ment of Defense Survivor Benefits Continuing Appropria-
- 3 tions Resolution, 2014".
