Mr. STOCKMAN submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the resolution (H. Res. 36) establishing a select committee to investigate and report on the attack on the United States consulate in Benghazi, Libya.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 the Speaker shall, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule XVIII,
3 declare the House resolved into the Committee of the
4 Whole House on the state of the Union for consideration
5 of the resolution (H. Res. 36) establishing a select com-
6 mittee to investigate and report on the attack on the
7 United States consulate in Benghazi, Libya. The first
8 reading of the resolution shall be dispensed with. All

1 points of order against the resolution and against its con-
2 sideration are waived. The resolution shall be considered
3 as read. General debate shall be confined to the resolution
4 and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and con-
5 trolled by the chair and ranking minority member of the
6 Committee on Rules. After general debate the resolution
7 shall be considered for amendment under the five-minute
8 rule. At the conclusion of consideration of the resolution
9 for amendment the Committee shall rise and report the
10 resolution to the House with such amendments as may
11 have been adopted. The previous question shall be consid-
12 ered as ordered on the resolution and amendments thereto
13 to adoption without intervening motion or demand for di-
14 vision of the question except one motion to recommit with
15 or without instructions.

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
