Mr. REID submitted the following resolution; which was considered and agreed to

## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment or recess of the Senate and an adjournment of the House of Representatives.

1       *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*  
2 *concurring)*, That when the Senate recesses or adjourns  
3 on any day from Thursday, August 1, 2013, through Sun-  
4 day, August 11, 2013, on a motion offered pursuant to  
5 this concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his  
6 designee, it stand recessed or adjourned until 12:00 noon  
7 on Monday, August 12, 2013, or such other time on that  
8 day as may be specified by its Majority Leader or his des-  
9 ignee in the motion to recess or adjourn; and that when  
10 the Senate recesses or adjourns on Monday, August 12,

1 2013, it stand adjourned until 12:00 noon on Monday,  
2 September 9, 2013, or such other time on that day as  
3 may be specified by its Majority Leader or his designee,  
4 or until the time of any reassembly pursuant to section  
5 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first; and  
6 that when the House adjourns on any legislative day from  
7 Friday, August 2, 2013, through Friday, September 6,  
8 2013, on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent res-  
9 olution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand  
10 adjourned until 2:00 p.m. on Monday, September 9, 2013,  
11 or until the time of any reassembly pursuant to section  
12 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first.

13       SEC. 2. The Majority Leader of the Senate and the  
14 Speaker of the House, or their respective designees, acting  
15 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the  
16 Senate and the Minority Leader of the House, shall notify  
17 the Members of the Senate and House, respectively, to re-  
18 assemble at such place and time as they may designate  
19 if, in their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
