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# HISTORY OF BILLS ENACTED INTO PUBLIC LAW

S. 1287, to provide for the storage of spent nuclear fuel pending completion of the nuclear waste repository, and for other purposes. Vetoed Apr. 25, 2000.

H.R. 4810, to provide for reconciliation pursuant to section 103(a)(1) of the concurrent resolution on the budget for fiscal year 2001. Vetoed Aug. 5, 2000.

H.R. 8, to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to phaseout the estate and gift taxes over a 10-year period. Vetoed Aug. 31, 2000.

H.R. 4733, making appropriations for energy and water development for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2001, and for other purposes. Vetoed Oct. 7, 2000.

H.R. 4516, making appropriations for the Legislative Branch for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2001, and for other purposes. Vetoed Oct. 30, 2000.

H.R. 4392, to authorize appropriations for fiscal year 2001 for intelligence and intelligence-related activities of the United States Government, the Community Management Account, and the Central Intelligence Agency Retirement and Disability System, and for other purposes. Vetoed Nov. 4, 2000.

H.R. 2415, to enhance security of United States missions and personnel overseas, to authorize appropriations for the Department of State for fiscal year 2000, and for other purposes. Pocket vetoed Dec. 19, 2000.
