The Committee on Rules, having had under consideration House Resolution 676, by a nonrecord vote, report the same to the House with the recommendation that the resolution be adopted.

SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS OF RESOLUTION

The resolution waives the provisions of clause 6(a) or rule XIII (requiring a two-thirds vote to consider a rule on the same day it is reported from the Rules Committee) against resolutions reported from the Rules Committee on December 15, 2000, providing for consideration or disposition of a conference report to accompany H.R. 4577 making appropriations for the Departments of Labor, Health and Human Services, and Education, and related agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2001, and for other purposes, or any amendment reported in disagreement from a conference thereon.
