The Committee on Rules, having had under consideration House Resolution 851, by a nonrecord vote, report the same to the House with the recommendation that the resolution be adopted.

SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS OF THE RESOLUTION

The resolution provides for consideration of H.R. 5522, the Foreign Operations, Export Financing and Related Programs Appropriations Act, 2007, under an open rule. The rule provides one hour of general debate equally divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee on Appropriations. The rule waives all points of order against consideration of the bill.

Under the rules of the House the bill shall be read for amendment by paragraph. The rule waives all points of order against provisions in the bill for failure to comply with clause 2 of rule XXI (prohibiting unauthorized appropriations or legislative provisions in an appropriations bill), except as specified in the resolution. The rule authorizes the Chair to accord priority in recognition to Members who have preprinted their amendments in the Congressional Record.

Finally, the rule provides one motion to recommit with or without instructions.

EXPLANATION OF WAIVERS

The waiver of all points of order against consideration of the bill includes a waiver of clause 4(c) of rule XIII (requiring the three-day availability of printed hearings on a general appropriation bill). The waiver of clause 2 of rule XXI (prohibiting unauthorized appro-

priations or legislative provisions in an appropriations bill) is necessary because there are numerous legislative provisions included in the bill.

The exemptions specified in the resolution to the waiver of clause 2 of rule XXI (prohibiting unauthorized appropriations or legislative provisions in an appropriations bill) against provisions in H.R. 5522 are as follows:

1. The number "5" on page 60, line 4;
2. Section 526;
3. Beginning with "Of" on page 86, line 1 through "That" on line 16;
4. Section 538;
5. Beginning with the semicolon in section 565(a)(2) through "501" in section 565(a)(3);
6. Section 570;
7. Section 579.
