**I. FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION**

In accordance with rule 18(e)(2) of the Committee on Standards of Official Conduct, the Committee hereby submits the following Report to the House of Representatives:

On December 8, 2009, the Committee convened for the purpose of considering the charge issued against Marc Philip Goldberg on August 14, 2009, of simple assault. Mr. Goldberg was convicted of simple assault on October 16, 2009, and sentenced to a 45 day suspended sentence and placed on supervised probation for one year. Mr. Goldberg was also fined \$700.00 and required to complete substance abuse treatment and testing, an anger management class, and 120 hours of community service. Mr. Goldberg has paid the \$700.00 fine and is complying with the terms of his sentence.

The Committee voted against empanelling an investigative subcommittee regarding this matter. The Committee considered the scope and nature of Mr. Goldberg's conduct, and the fine and criminal disposition ordered by the D.C. Superior Court. The Committee has determined not to initiate review by an investigative subcommittee in this matter.
