49.15 PROVIDING FOR THE CONSIDERATION OF H.R. 2039

Mr. DERRICK, by direction of the Committee on Rules, called up the following resolution (H. Res. 444):

Resolved, That at any time after the adoption of this resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of the Whole House on the State of the Union for the further consideration of the bill (H.R. 2039) to authorize appropriations for the Legal Services Corporation, and for other purposes. An additional period of general debate, which shall be confined to the bill and which shall not exceed thirty minutes, to be equally divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member of the Judiciary, shall be in order. Following the additional period of general debate, the bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-minute rule. It shall be in order to consider the amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee on the Judiciary now printed in the bill as an original bill for the purpose of amendment under the five-minute rule and said substitute shall be considered as having been read. No amendment to said substitute shall be in order except the amendments printed in the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution. Said amendments shall be considered in the order and manner specified in the report and shall be

considered as having been read. Said amendments shall be debatable for the period specified in the report, equally divided and controlled by the proponent and a member opposed thereto. Said amendments shall not be subject to amendment except as specified in the report of the Committee on Rules. It shall be in order at any time for the chairman of the Committee on the Judiciary to offer amendments en bloc consisting of amendments, and modifications in the text of any amendments which are germane thereto, printed in the report of the Committee on Rules. Such amendments en bloc shall be considered as having been read and shall be debatable for not to exceed twenty minutes, equally divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee on the Judiciary. The original proponents of the amendments en bloc shall have permission to insert statements in the Congressional Record immediately before disposition of the amendments en bloc. Such amendments en bloc shall not be subject to amendment, or to a demand for a division of the question in the House or in the Committee of the Whole. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amendment, the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House with such amendments as may have been adopted, and any Member may demand a separate vote in the House or any amendment adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to the committee amendment in the nature of a substitute. The previous question shall be considered as having been ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage without intervening motion except one motion to recommend with or without instructions.

When said resolution was considered. After debate,

On motion of Mr. DERRICK, the previous question was ordered on the resolution to its adoption or rejection.

The question being put, viva voce,

Will the House agree to said resolution?

The SPEAKER pro tempore, Mrs. UNSOELD, announced that the yeas had it.

Mr. QUILLEN objected to the vote on the ground that a quorum was not present and not voting.
