49.18 LEGAL SERVICES CORPORATION

The SPEAKER pro tempore, Mrs. UNSOELD, pursuant to House Resolution 444 and rule XXIII, declared the House resolved into the Committee of the Whole House on the state of the Union for the further consideration of the bill (H.R. 2039) to authorize appropriations for the Legal Services Corporation, and for other purposes.

Mr. MFUME, Chairman of the Committee of the Whole, resumed the chair; and after some time spent therein,

49.19 RECORDED VOTE

A recorded vote by electronic device was ordered in the Committee of the Whole on the following amendments en bloc, as modified, submitted by Mr. BROOKS:

Page 31, line 11, strike "legal assistance".

Page 24, strike lines 14 through 19 and insert the following:

"except that the Corporation—

"(I) shall, upon application, grant waivers of the requirements of this clause for a legal

services program, supported under section 222(a)(3) of the Economic Opportunity Act of 1964, which on the date of the enactment of this title has a majority of persons who are not attorneys on its policymaking board, and

"(II) may grant, pursuant to regulations issued by the Corporation, a waiver of the requirements of this clause for recipients which, because of the nature of the population they serve, are unable to comply with such requirements; and

21. The amendment to be offered by Representative FRANK of Massachusetts or his designee, debatable for not to exceed 20 minutes:

Page 17, line 8, strike the quotation marks and second period.

Page 17, insert the following after line 8:

"(5) Notwithstanding the preceding provisions of this subsection, the Inspector General of the Corporation shall not, in carrying out his or her functions, be subject to any restriction that—

"(A) is contained in the standards and procedures adopted by the Corporation under this subsection; and

"(B) limits access by the Corporation to documents or other information."

Modification to the amendment offered by Mr. FRANK to H.R. 2039, As Reported:

Add at the end of the amendment the following:

In section 1007(d)(2) of the Legal Services Corporation Act, as contained in section 6(c) of the bill, in the last sentence strike "an investigation" and insert "an audit, or to an investigation".

Page 42, line 22, insert after "12 months" the following: ", except for any grant to a new program commencing operation after the beginning of the applicable calendar year."
