¶62.19 CLERK TO CORRECT ENGROSSMENT

On motion of Mr. SPENCE, by unanimous consent,

Ordered, That in the engrossment of the foregoing bill the Clerk be authorized to (1) insert at the end of title XIV (rather than at the end of title XII) the sections inserted by the action of the Committee of the Whole in adopting amendments numbered 6, 8, and 10 of House Report 106-175; and (2) the Clerk may make corrections to section numbers, cross references, the table of contents and punctuation, and such other clerical corrections as may be necessary to reflect the actions of the House in amending the bill.

¶62.20 PERMISSION TO FILE REPORT

On motion of Mr. LEACH, by unanimous consent, the Committee on Banking and Financial Services was granted permission to file a supplemental report (Rept. No. 106-74, Part 2) on the bill (H.R. 10) to enhance competition in the financial services industry by providing a prudential framework for the affiliation of banks, securities firms, and other financial service providers, and for other purposes.
