ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANT'S MOTION TO ALLOW THE TAKING OF PLAINTIFF'S DEPOSITION IN PRISON, (Dkt. #14)

This matter is before the Court on the Defendant's Motion to Allow the Taking of Plaintiff's Deposition in Prison, (Dkt. #14) filed on February 22, 2008.
