Dear Mr. Chairman:

The Government Printing Office's Atlanta Regional Printing Procurement Office, currently located at 1888 Emery Street, NW, Suite 110, Atlanta, GA 30318-2542, comprises 4355 sq. ft of space at a cost of \$21.36/sq ft, for a lease of \$93,022.80 annually. The lease there is expiring. Next month the office plans to relocate to another facility under a new lease for 3,048 sq ft of space at \$20.50/sq ft, or \$62,484 annually, a reduction of \$30,538.80 or about 33%.

The new facility is located at 3715 Northside Parkway, Suite 4-305, Atlanta, GA 30327, approximately 4.5 miles away from the current facility. In 1992, when the current space was first occupied, the Atlanta office had 28 employees. The office currently staffs 8 employees and has one vacancy. The new lease starts August 1, and the office plans to be completely moved in on August 6. Along with the move, measures are being taken to notify the office's customer agencies of the change in address, phone numbers, and related information via GPO circular letter, Facebook, Twitter, taglines in office e-mail, and personal e-mails/conversations from the Atlanta staff.

The Joint Committee on Printing resolution of May 11, 1982, requires the prior approval of the Committee for relocations of GPO facilities. Accordingly, I am respectfully requesting your approval to complete this cost-saving relocation.
