**NOTE:** Bruce R. James, of Nevada, was nominated to be Public  
Printer on August 1. The Public Printer is the head of the  
U.S. Government Printing Office.

James was CEO of Barclays Law Publishers until retiring in 1993. Since his retirement, he has gone on to become chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Rochester Institute of Technology and chairman-elect of Sierra Nevada College at Lake Tahoe, founded by Nevada New-Tech, Inc., a company formed to invest in technology-based enterprises that promise to broaden and diversify Nevada's economy. James is the chairman of the Congressional Roundtable of Printing Industries of America, a trustee of the National Technical Institute for the Deaf, the State chairman of United Way's Alexis de Tocqueville Society, and a member of the advisory board of UNLV's Boyd School of Law. James is a graduate of the Rochester Institute of Technology.
