PUBLIC PRINTER TO SPEAK AT WHITE HOUSE ENVIRONMENTAL EVENT

WHO: Public Printer Bob Tapella will speak at the first GreenGov Symposium. He was invited by The White House Council on Environmental Quality to discuss how the employees at the U.S. Government Printing Office (GPO) have been successful in practicing sustainable environmental stewardship. Tapella will address how GPO's green initiatives have become a model for others to learn from at the "Waste Reduction in Office" session at the event.

WHAT: The White House Council on Environmental Quality will hold the first GreenGov Symposium on October 5-7, 2010, hosted by The George Washington University on its Foggy Bottom Campus in Washington, D.C. The 2010 GreenGov Symposium represents the first time the Obama Administration will bring together leaders from federal, state and local governments, nonprofit and academic communities and the private sector to identify opportunities around greening the federal government.
