RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the resolution (H. Res. 279) providing for the expenses of certain committees of the House of Representatives in the One Hundred Eleventh Congress.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order without intervention of any point of
3 order to consider in the House the resolution (H. Res.
4 279) providing for the expenses of certain committees of
5 the House of Representatives in the One Hundred Elev-

1 enth Congress. The amendment in the nature of a sub-
2 stitute recommended by the Committee on House Admin-
3 istration now printed in the resolution shall be considered
4 as adopted. The resolution, as amended, shall be consid-
5 ered as read. The previous question shall be considered
6 as ordered on the resolution, as amended, to final adoption
7 without intervening motion or demand for division of the
8 question except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and
9 controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of
10 the Committee on House Administration; and (2) one mo-
11 tion to recommit which may not contain instructions.
