A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on helical springs not suitable for use in motor-vehicle suspension, of iron or steel wire having a cross-sectional dimension of 12.7 mm or more.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. HELICAL SPRINGS NOT SUITABLE FOR USE IN**
4 **MOTOR-VEHICLE SUSPENSION, OF IRON OR**
5 **STEEL WIRE HAVING A CROSS-SECTIONAL DI-**
6 **MENSION OF 12.7 MM OR MORE.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
8 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is

1 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
 2 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Helical springs not suitable for use in motor-vehicle suspension, of iron or steel wire having a cross-sectional dimension of 12.7 mm or more (provided for in subheading 7320.20.50)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2015	”.
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3 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
 4 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
 5 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
 6 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
