AN ACT

To amend title 38, United States Code, to require the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to retain a copy of any reprimand or admonishment received by an employee of the Department in the permanent record of the employee.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Ensuring VA Em-
3 ployee Accountability Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. RETENTION OF RECORDS OF REPRIMANDS AND AD-**
5 **MONISHMENTS RECEIVED BY EMPLOYEES OF**
6 **THE DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 7 of title 38, United
8 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
9 lowing new section:

10 **“§ 714. Record of reprimands and admonishments**

11 “If any employee of the Department receives a rep-
12 rimand or admonishment, the Secretary shall retain a
13 copy of such reprimand or admonishment in the perma-
14 nent record of the employee as long as the employee is
15 employed by the Department.”.

1 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
2 at the beginning of such chapter is amended by adding
3 at the end the following new item:

“714. Record of reprimands and admonishments.”.
