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GPO TO TAKE PART IN LEGISLATIVE DATA AND TRANSPARENCY CONFERENCE

WHO:

WHAT:

At the invitation of the House Committee on House Administration, staff from the U.S. Government Printing Office (GPO) will be on hand to speak at the 2013 Legislative Data and Transparency Conference, along with staff from other legislative branch agencies, data users, and transparency advocates. GPO will discuss preservation objectives, practices, and strategies that ensure legislative content is permanently available in electronic format. GPO will also present on a committee vote utility initiative that will record and organize the votes of each committee member in an XML format into the committee report, which will take the place of users having to type in the Member names and vote results for commonly taken votes. Additionally, GPO is collaborating with the Library of Congress and will discuss the digitization efforts of the bound Congressional Record and Statutes at Large.
