GPO SUPERINTENDENT OF DOCUMENTS RECEIVES RAYMOND VON DRAN MEMORIAL AWARD

WASHINGTON – The U.S. Government Publishing Office (GPO) Superintendent of Documents Laurie Hall receives the 2021 Raymond Von Dran Memorial Award from the Catholic University of America (CUA) Library and Information Science (LIS) Alumni Association. The honor is bestowed each year to an alumnus of Catholic University's School of Library and Information Science who, through their contributions to the library and information science profession, has exhibited the qualities that Dean Von Dran was noted for throughout his career: innovation, collaboration, and leadership.

"Laurie plays a critical role as GPO Superintendent of Documents supporting the GPO mission *Keeping America Informed* and ensuring free public access to Government information. As Managing Director of Library Services and Content Management, Hall oversees the administration of four major Congressionally-mandated programs: the Federal Depository Library Program (FDLP), the Cataloging & Indexing Program, the International Exchange Service, and the By-Law Program.

Hall has been with GPO since 1985.
