- GPO is fully ready to support Advance Orders (GINV Deposit Accounts) and Non-Advance Orders using Standard Order Processing.
- GT&C (7600A) Templates and Order (7600B) Submission Guidelines are available on our [GPO GINV webpage](#).
- GPO is hosting GINV Info Session webinars to provide customers with useful information on doing business with GPO in GINV.
 - Info Sessions are currently scheduled throughout December and January.

- GPO Ordering Forms are still required (SF1, 2511, 4044, 3001, etc.) along with the GINV GT&C, Order, Line, and Schedule information.
- GPO Form 4045-GINV is still required for Advance Orders
- New Circular Letter 1144 - GPO recommends that our customer agencies prepare their Legacy Deposit Accounts for the transition into G-Invoicing (GINV).
- GPO will be releasing new GPO Form 400s to support GINV Performance transactions.
