9/11 COMMISSION REPORT AVAILABLE AS AN eBook

WASHINGTON— As Americans everywhere observe the 10th anniversary of the 9/11 attacks on the World Trade Center, the Pentagon, and in Shanksville, PA, the U.S. Government Printing Office (GPO) has made available for the first-time the official edition of the *9/11 Commission Report* in an eBook format. The report details the circumstances surrounding the September 11, 2001, terrorist attacks, including preparedness for and the immediate response to the attacks, and provides recommendations designed to guard against future attacks. The book is available in print format at GPO's retail and online bookstore. The entire report is also accessible through GPO's Federal Digital System (FDsys), a one-stop site to authentic, published Government information.
