SPECIAL EDITION OF PENTAGON 9/11 AVAILABLE AT GPO

WASHINGTON—As the Nation remembers the victims of the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001, the U.S. Government Printing Office (GPO) has made available the 10th anniversary edition of *Pentagon 9/11* at the agency's retail and online bookstore. This anniversary edition features a new foreword by Secretary of Defense Leon Panetta. The book provides a comprehensive account of the attack and the aftermath, including unprecedented details on the impact on the Pentagon building and personnel and the scope of the rescue, recovery, and care-giving effort. Pentagon 9/11 also features interviews, unpublished photographs, diagrams, and illustrations.
