GPO AND OMB RELEASE PRESIDENT BIDEN'S FY2022 BUDGET

WASHINGTON – The U.S. Government Publishing Office (GPO) and the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) have released President Biden's Fiscal Year 2022 Budget. GPO works with OMB to produce and distribute the President's Budget, an annual tradition since the Budget and Accounting Act was established in 1921.

The following are the volumes that make up the President's Federal Budget:

Budget of the U.S. Government – Contains the Budget Message of the President, information on the President's priorities, and summary tables.

Appendix – Contains detailed information on the various appropriations and funds that constitute the budget.

Analytical Perspectives – Contains analyses that are designed to highlight specified subject areas or provide other significant presentations of budget data that place the budget in perspective.

GPO is the Federal Government's official, digital, secure resource for producing, procuring, cataloging, indexing, authenticating, disseminating, and preserving the official information products of the U.S. Government. The GPO is responsible for the production and distribution of information products and services for all three branches of the Federal Government, including U.S. passports for the Department of State as well as the official publications of Congress, the White House, and other Federal agencies in digital and print







formats. GPO provides for permanent public access to Federal Government information at no charge through <u>www.govinfo.gov</u> and partnerships with approximately 1,100 libraries nationwide participating in the Federal Depository Library Program.
