Prior to image processing, the contractor shall perform a basic check (preflight) of the furnished media and publishing files to assure correct output of the required reproduction image. Any errors, media damage, or data corruption that might interfere with proper file image processing must be reported to the contract administrator.

The contractor shall create or change any necessary trapping, set proper screen angles and screen frequency, and define file output selection for the imaging device being utilized. Furnished files must be imaged as necessary to meet the assigned quality level.

Contractor to combine the appropriate number of word files for each Item (each Item is in a separate folder) and add consecutive page numbers on each page and create the Table of Contents for each book. (The first page of each separate word file starts as an odd page. Contractor to add blanks as required. Note: Some pages include a printed page number that may need to be changed. See file counts for each item under "Pages" herein.

Contractor to create the Table of Contents for each of the 10 items. (See attachment 1 for an example of a Table of Contents shell which is provided with each book). Contractor to format and add page numbers.

PAPER and BINDER SAMPLES: Contractor to submit a minimum of 15 8-1/2 x 11" blank sheets of the actual paper and two samples of the 3-ring binders that will be used in the production of the contract requirements for approval. Each sample must be of the kind and quality required by the specifications. The Government will rely on the samples only as a reference to the general appearance of the stock that will be provided by the contractor in conformance to the specifications. The Government assumes no contractual obligation to perform any inspection and test for the benefit of the contractor. The Government's failure to inspect and accept or reject the paper samples shall not relieve the contractor from responsibility, nor impose liability on the Government, for nonconforming paper. PRIOR TO PRODUCTION SAMPLES: Prior to the commencement of production of the contract production quantity, the contractor shall submit samples to: Garth Carr, Customer Data Relations Management, 1001 Barnett Ave., Quantico VA 22134, phone 571-767-8050. 5 samples will be tested for conformance of material(s) and will be tested for usage on the specified equipment and/or for construction and color and pantone match. The container and accompanying documentation shall be marked PREPRODUCTION SAMPLES and shall include the GPO jacket, purchase order, and program numbers. The samples must be submitted in sufficient time to allow Government testing of the samples and production and shipment in accordance with the shipping schedule.

The Government will approve, conditionally approve, or disapprove the samples within 5 workdays of the receipt thereof. Approval or conditional approval shall not relieve the contractor from complying with the specifications and all other terms and conditions of the contract. A conditional approval shall state any further action required by the contractor. A notice of disapproval shall state the reasons therefor.

If the samples are disapproved by the Government, the Government, at its option, may require the contractor to submit additional samples for inspection and test, in the time and under the terms and conditions specified in the notice of rejection. Such additional samples shall be furnished, and necessary changes made, at no additional cost to the Government and with no extension in the shipping schedule. The Government will require the time specified above to inspect and test any additional samples required.

In the event the additional samples are disapproved by the Government, the contractor shall be deemed to have failed to make delivery within the meaning of the default clause in which event this contract shall be subject to termination for default, provided however, that the failure of the Government to terminate the contract for default in such event shall not relieve the contractor of the responsibility to deliver the contract quantities in accordance with the shipping schedule.

In the event the Government fails to approve, conditionally approve, or disapprove the samples within the time specified, the Contracting Officer shall automatically extend the shipping schedule in accordance with Contract Clause 12, "Notice of Compliance with Schedules," of GPO Contract Terms (GPO Publication 310.2, effective December 1, 1987 (Rev. 01-18)).

Manufacture of the final product prior to approval of the sample submitted is at the contractor's risk. Samples will not be returned to the contractor. All costs, including the costs of all samples shall be included in the contract price for the production quantity.

All samples shall be manufactured at the facilities in which the contract production quantities are to be manufactured.

STOCK/PAPER: The specifications of all paper furnished must be in accordance with those listed herein or listed for the corresponding JCP Code numbers in the "Government Paper Specification Standards No. 12" dated March 2011.

Cover and Spine: JCP Code* L70, Coated One Side (C1S) Cover, Point Size 12 pt.

Text: FOR STUDENT TEXT and for INSTRUCTOR GUIDE: JCP Code* A80, Opacified Offset Book, Basis Size 25 X 38" 60lbs.

**The requirement for postconsumer fiber (as specified in the Government Paper Specification Standards No. 12) for this contract is waived. However, the addition of post-consumer fiber is encouraged provided that the requirements of this Standard are met. All other attributes remain the same.

THREE RING BINDERS FOR INSTRUCTOR GUIDES:

Contractor to provide 2,690 total binders, 538 copies each of item 6 thru 10 of suitable capacity for each item with three round rings spaced 4-1/4" center to center and upright opening & closing levers at each end (levers must not extend beyond the edges of the binder). STOCK: Virgin Vinyl, approximately 8 mil thick. Finish smooth.

Color White. CONSTRUCTION: Cover and backbone boards must be Number 1 quality binder boards approximately 102mil. Thick with smooth edges and outer corners rounded. Grain of boards must be perpendicular to the hinge. The vinyl covering must be electronically or dielectrically heat-sealed over the boards forming securely sealed edges all around the binder and on each side of the backbone as hinges. The metal looseleaf element must be securely riveted to the backbone, with no free play, by not less than two (2) metal rivets. All exposed metal parts must be nickel-plated and corrosion resistant. Full Clear Vinyl Pockets with openings at the top on: Front Cover, Spine and Back Cover. 5" deep horizontal pockets on bottom edge of inside front and inside back cover. Pockets must be heat-sealed at all closed edges. Hidden rivets must not extend or show through the outer cover.

METAL LOOSELEAF ELEMENT: Opening/closing levers must have a firm action with no free play.

Standard Base Element. Must be of the standard weight and thickness, machine finished, with no rough edges.

Heavy Duty Wide Flat Base Element. Must have spring back for uniform tension, alignment of rings, and smooth operation.

Each binder must be equipped with two (2) full length plastic sheet lifters with all corners rounded.

PRINTING:

Digital Printing NOT Acceptable.

STUDENT Covers 1, 4 and spine print solids, screen tints, illustrations, type and rule matter in 4-color process, with some type and illustrations reversing out to appear white on a full coverage background. Covers 2 and 3 blank. Full uncommon bleeds on all sides. After printing flood coat the entire surface of the face of Cover 1, 4 and spine with a flood gloss aqueous coating. Contractor to position text for spine. Contractor to adjust spine of cover as needed.

STUDENT Text: Pages print with fine detail graphs, charts, screen tints, illustrations, type and rule matter in Black ink, with some type and illustrations reversing out to appear white. Landscapes pages scattered throughout and print head to bind for odd pages and head to open side for even pages.

INSTRUCTOR GUIDE Covers 1, 4 and spine print solids, screen tints, illustrations, type and rule matter in 4-color process, with some type and illustrations reversing out to appear white on a full coverage background. Covers 2 and 3 blank. Full uncommon bleeds on all sides. After printing flood coat the entire surface of the face of Cover 1, 4 and spine with a flood gloss aqueous coating.

INSTRUCTOR GUIDE Text: Pages print head to head with fine detail graphs, screen tints, illustrations, type and rule matter in black ink, with some type and illustrations reversing out to appear white. A fine detail seals prints on scattered pages throughout. Landscapes pages scattered throughout and print head to bind for odd pages and head to open side for even pages.

MARGINS:

Covers: Inadequate gripper, bleeds all sides.

Text: adequate gripper, follow furnished electronic media.

DIGITAL DELIVERABLE: Upon completion, the contractor must furnish one CD-R with final production files of all ten items converted to a single simple Acrobat PDF file "Optimized for Press" with proper color mode. CD-R disc must be ISO 9660 compliant.

BINDING:

STUDENT BOOKS: Perfect-bind text and wraparound cover; trim three sides.

Hinge score 1/4" from left side. Grain of cover must run parallel to the spine. Contractor to determine spine thickness and adjust backstrip if necessary. Type must center on width of spine.

INSTRUCTOR BOOKS: DRILLING: Drill 3 round holes 5/16 inch diameter 4-1/4 inch center to center; center on 11 inch dimension; center of holes 3/8" from left edge of sheet for all text pages. Collate text and place in an appropriate size 3 ring binder, (3", 2-1/2", 2", 1-1/2" or 1 inch binders).

Insert appropriate printed INSTRUCTOR GUIDE Cover 1 inside the front plastic sleeve. Insert appropriate size INSTRUCTOR GUIDE Spine inside the spine plastic sleeve. Insert appropriate printed INSTRUCTOR GUIDE Cover 4 inside the back plastic sleeve. (see above for binder description).

PACKING:

Pack suitable in shipping containers. Separate Instructor and Student Books and pack boxes by Individual Titles to each specified location. There are 10 Titles. See Distribution list for number of Addresses.

All shipments which fill less than a shipping container must be packaged with materials of sufficient strength and durability and in such a manner which will guarantee that the product will not be damaged and the package will not open nor split when processed through the U.S. mail system, commercial freight or a small package carrier delivery system.
