Mr. DOOLITTLE introduced the following joint resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Post Office and Civil Service

JOINT RESOLUTION

Designating the week of June 1 through June 7, 1993, as "National Polio Awareness Week".

Whereas there are an estimated 650,000 paralytic survivors in the United States today;

Whereas knowledge about the late effects of polio is beginning to spread to all polio survivors, the health care community, and the general public; and

Whereas the International Polio Network and over 300 local polio support organizations have been instrumental in coordinating efforts to promote research on and increase the awareness of the late effects of polio: Now, therefore be it

2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the week of June 1 through June 7, 1993 be des-
4 ignated as “National Polio Awareness Week”.
