Mr. DARDEN introduced the following joint resolution; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution relating to Federal budget procedures.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled*
3 *(two-thirds of each House concurring therein), That the fol-*
4 *lowing article is proposed as an amendment to the Con-*
5 *stitution of the United States, which shall be valid only*
6 *if ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several*
7 *States within seven years after its submission to the*
8 *States for ratification:*

1 those derived from borrowing, and total outlays includes
2 all outlays of the United States except those for repayment
3 of debt principal.

4 “SECTION 5. This article shall take effect with re-
5 spect to the second fiscal year beginning after the date
6 on which this article is ratified.

7 “SECTION 6. Congress may enforce and implement
8 this article by appropriate legislation.”.
