## **JOINT RESOLUTION**

Designating May 22, 1994, as "National Neighbor Day".

Whereas the increased incidents of crime, drugs, and violence  
have continued to plague our cities and towns;

Whereas many people have become alienated from their  
neighbors; and

Whereas in light of these recent developments which have af-  
fected all of us, all citizens of the United States are en-  
couraged to signify their support for peace, harmony, and  
friendship by introducing themselves and extending a  
warm welcome to new people in their neighborhoods, as  
well as renewing old friendships: Now, therefore, be it

1        *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*  
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3 That May 22, 1994 is designated as “National Neighbor  
4 Day”, and the President is authorized and requested to  
5 issue a proclamation calling upon the people of the United  
6 States to observe such day with appropriate ceremonies  
7 and activities.
