## A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to acquire parcels of land commonly known as Fisherman's Cove and Gull Island for inclusion in the Edwin B. Forsythe National Wildlife Refuge in Monmouth County and Ocean County, New Jersey.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ACQUISITION OF LAND.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Interior, act-  
5 ing through the Director of the United States Fish and  
6 Wildlife Service and subject to the availability of appro-  
7 priations, may acquire for inclusion in the Edwin B. For-

1 sythe National Wildlife Refuge the land described in sub-  
2 section (b), or such portion of that land as the Secretary  
3 considers appropriate.

4 (b) LAND DESCRIBED.—The lands referred to in sub-  
5 section (a) are the parcel in Monmouth County, New Jer-  
6 sey, commonly known as Fisherman’s Cove, consisting of  
7 land bordered by Brielle Road, Third Avenue, and the  
8 Manasquan River and depicted on the Borough of  
9 Manasquan Tax Map on file with the Borough Engineer,  
10 Borough of Manasquan, Monmouth County, New Jersey,  
11 and the parcel in Ocean County, New Jersey commonly  
12 known as Gull Island, consisting of land located in the  
13 Manasquan River.

14 (c) MANAGEMENT OF ACQUIRED LAND.—Land ac-  
15 quired by the Secretary of the Interior under this section  
16 shall be managed as part of the Edwin B. Forsythe Na-  
17 tional Wildlife Refuge in accordance with the purposes for  
18 which that refuge was established.
