A BILL

To amend the National Agricultural Research, Extension, and Teaching Policy Act of 1977 to extend eligibility to junior and community colleges for grants and fellowships for food and agricultural sciences education.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ELIGIBILITY FOR GRANTS AND FELLOWSHIPS**

4 **FOR FOOD AND AGRICULTURAL SCIENCES**

5 **EDUCATION.**

6 Section 1417 of the National Agricultural Research,
7 Extension, and Teaching Policy Act of 1977 (7 U.S.C.

1 3152) is amended by adding at the end the following new
2 subsection:

3 “(j) DEFINITIONS.—For purposes of this section:

4 “(1) The terms ‘college’ and ‘university’ include
5 a junior or community college.

6 “(2) The term ‘junior or community college’
7 means an educational institution that—

8 “(A) admits as regular students persons
9 who are beyond the age of compulsory school
10 attendance in the State in which the institution
11 is located and who have the ability to benefit
12 from the training offered by the institution;

13 “(B) does not provide an educational pro-
14 gram for which it awards a bachelor’s degree
15 (or an equivalent degree); and

16 “(C) provides an educational program of
17 not less than 2 years that is acceptable for full
18 credit toward such a degree.”.
