7 Of the funds made available under this heading
8 (other than the \$300,000,000 provided for grants to carry
9 out an urban revitalization demonstration program) in the
10 Departments of Veterans Affairs and Housing and Urban
11 Development, and Independent Agencies Appropriations
12 Act, 1993 (Pub. L. 102-389; 106 Stat. 1579),
13 \$275,000,000 is rescinded and \$50,000,000 shall be
14 transferred to and merged with the appropriation in such
15 Act for “HOME investment partnerships program”.

16 Of the funds made available under this heading in
17 the Departments of Veterans Affairs and Housing and
18 Urban Development, and Independent Agencies Appro-
19 priations Act, 1992 (Pub. L. 102-139; 105 Stat. 743),
20 \$125,000,000 is rescinded and \$25,000,000 shall be
21 transferred to and merged with the appropriation in such
22 Act for “HOME investment partnerships program”.
