## A BILL

To amend title 23, United States Code, to establish a formula for allocating funds apportioned to the territories for the National Highway System among the territories.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       That, effective September 30, 1993, section 104(b)(1) of  
4       title 23, United States Code, is amended by striking “1  
5       percent to the Virgin Islands, Guam, American Samoa,  
6       and the Commonwealth of Northern Mariana Islands” and  
7       inserting the following: “ $\frac{1}{12}$  of 1 percent to American  
8       Samoa,  $\frac{5}{12}$  of 1 percent to Guam,  $\frac{5}{12}$  of 1 percent to

1 the Virgin Islands, and  $\frac{1}{12}$  of 1 percent to the Common-  
2 wealth of the Northern Mariana Islands”.
