A BILL

To amend title 49, United States Code, to provide that the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration shall be appointed for a term of 7 years.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TERM OF SERVICE OF FAA ADMINISTRATOR.**

4 Section 106(b) of title 49, United States Code, is
5 amended by inserting after the 3rd sentence the following:
6 “The term of service of the Administrator shall be 7
7 years.”.

1 **SEC. 2. APPLICABILITY.**

2 The amendment made by section 1 shall be effective
3 with respect to any individual appointed by the President,
4 by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, after
5 September 30, 1993, as the Administrator of the Federal
6 Aviation Administration.
