A BILL

To suspend for the period January 1, 1994, to April 30, 1994, the duty on frozen onions.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TEMPORARY DUTY SUSPENSION ON FROZEN**

4 **ONIONS.**

5 Subchapter II of chapter 99 of the Harmonized Tar-
6 iff Schedule of the United States is amended by inserting
7 in numerical sequence the following new heading:

“	9902.07.11	Onions, frozen (provided for in subheading 0710.80.97)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 4/30/94	”.

1 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—The amendment made by section
3 1 applies with respect to goods entered, or withdrawn from
4 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
5 the date of the enactment of this Act.

6 (b) RELIQUIDATION.—Notwithstanding section 514
7 of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1514) or any other
8 provision of law, upon proper request filed with the appro-
9 priate customs officer on or before the date which is 90
10 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, any entry,
11 or withdrawal from warehouse for consumption, that was
12 made—

13 (1) after December 31, 1993, and before the
14 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act,
15 and

16 (2) with respect to which there would have been
17 no duty if the amendment made by section 1 applied
18 to such entry or withdrawal,
19 shall be liquidated or reliquidated as though such amend-
20 ment applied to such entry or withdrawal.
