## A BILL

To prohibit the Secretary of Defense from transporting across State lines chemical munitions in the chemical weapons stockpile, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION OF TRANSPORTATION ACROSS**  
4                       **STATE LINES OF CHEMICAL MUNITIONS IN**  
5                       **CHEMICAL WEAPONS STOCKPILE.**

6       The Secretary of Defense may not transport any  
7       chemical munition that constitutes part of the chemical  
8       weapons stockpile out of the State in which that munition  
9       is located on the date of the enactment of this Act and,  
10      in the case of any such chemical munition not located in

1 a State on the date of the enactment of this Act, may  
2 not transport any such munition into a State.

3 **SEC. 2. TRANSPORTATION OF CHEMICAL MUNITIONS NOT**  
4 **IN CHEMICAL WEAPONS STOCKPILE.**

5 The Secretary of Defense shall transport to the near-  
6 est chemical munitions stockpile facility any chemical mu-  
7 nitions that are discovered or otherwise come within the  
8 control of the Department of Defense and that do not con-  
9 stitute part of the chemical weapons stockpile.
