1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

2       The United States courthouse to be constructed at  
3 907 Richland Street in Columbia, South Carolina, shall  
4 be known and designated as the “Matthew J. Perry, Jr.  
5 United States Courthouse”.

6 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

7       Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,  
8 paper, or other record of the United States to the United  
9 States courthouse referred to in section 1 shall be deemed  
10 to be a reference to the “Matthew J. Perry, Jr. United  
11 States Courthouse”.
