7 which right, title, and interest is conveyed under sub-  
8 section (a) ceases to be used by the City of Imperial  
9 Beach, California, for public recreational purposes—

10 (1) all such right, title, and interest shall revert  
11 to the Government of the United States; and

12 (2) such land shall be reincorporated into the  
13 Tijuana Slough National Wildlife Refuge.
