Mr. DEUTSCH introduced the following bill; which was referred to the

A BILL

To require the Administrator of General Services to convey to the city of Key West, Florida, each of 2 parcels of land of the Naval Air Station Key West in Key West, Florida, at such time as the parcel is reported to the Administrator as excess to the needs of the Department of the Navy.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CONVEYANCE OF LAND TO THE CITY OF KEY**
4 **WEST, FLORIDA.**

5 (a) REQUIREMENT.—Notwithstanding any other pro-
6 vision of law, the Administrator of General Services shall

1 convey to the city of Key West, Florida, each of the parcels
2 of real property described in subsection (c), at such time
3 as the parcel is reported to the General Services Adminis-
4 tration as excess to the needs of the Department of the
5 Navy.

6 (b) TERMS.—A conveyance of property under this
7 section shall be by quitclaim deed, without monetary con-
8 sideration, and subject to such other terms and conditions
9 as the Administrator determines to be appropriate.

10 (c) PROPERTY DESCRIBED.—The real property re-
11 ferred to in subsection (a) consists of 2 separate parcels
12 in Key West, Florida, as follows:

13 (1) Approximately 1.82 acres of land and im-
14 provements located on Simonton Street and known
15 as the Simonton Street Commissary Store of the
16 Naval Air Station Key West.

17 (2) Approximately 36.16 acres of land and im-
18 provements known as the Poinciana Housing of the
19 Naval Air Station Key West.
