## A BILL

To reauthorize special immigrant provisions for certain retirees.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REAUTHORIZATION OF SPECIAL IMMIGRANT**  
4 **PROVISIONS FOR CERTAIN RETIREES.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 101(a)(27)(I) of the Im-  
6 migration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101(a)(27)(I))  
7 is amended by striking clause (iii)(II) in its entirety and  
8 inserting in lieu thereof the following: “(II) files a petition  
9 for status under this subparagraph no later than six  
10 months after the date of such retirement or six months

1 after the date of enactment of this Act, whichever is later;  
2 or”.

3 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
4 this Act shall take effect on the date of enactment of this  
5 Act.
