Ms. MOLINARI introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Public Works and Transportation

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## A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Army to conduct a review of the report of the Chief of Engineers on Staten Island from Fort Wadsworth to Arthur Kill, New York, and for other purposes.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3        **SECTION 1. REVIEW AND STUDIES.**

4        The Secretary of the Army shall review the report  
5        of the Chief of Engineers on the Staten Island Coast from  
6        Fort Wadsworth to Arthur Kill, New York, published as  
7        House Document Number 181, Eighty-ninth Congress,  
8        and other pertinent reports for Staten Island, in response

1 to the major storm damages of the Northeaster of Decem-  
2 ber 11–13, 1992. The purpose of the review shall be to  
3 determine whether modifications of the recommendations  
4 contained in such report are advisable at the present time.  
5 In addition, the Secretary shall conduct a comprehensive  
6 study of the shore of Staten Island, and at the earliest  
7 time possible, investigations for the severely impacted  
8 communities of New Dorp Beach, Oakwood Beach, and  
9 Annadale Beach to analyze the vulnerability of these  
10 coastal areas and the causes for the ongoing erosion, in-  
11 cluding those processes which have been accelerated by the  
12 storm impacts.

13 **SEC. 2. REPORT.**

14 Not later than 1 year after the date of the enactment  
15 of this Act, the Secretary of the Army shall transmit to  
16 the Committee on Public Works and Transportation of the  
17 House of Representatives and the Committee on Environ-  
18 ment and Public Works of the Senate a report on the re-  
19 sults of the review, study, and investigations conducted  
20 under section 1.

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
