Mr. SIMON introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To extend the deadlines applicable to certain hydroelectric projects under the Federal Power Act, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROJECT NUMBER 3943.**

4 (a) EXTENSION.—Notwithstanding the time limita-
5 tions of section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C.
6 806), the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (re-
7 ferred to in this Act as the “Commission”), upon the re-
8 quest of the licensee for FERC Project No. 3943 (and
9 after reasonable notice), may extend the time required for
10 commencement of construction of such project for not

1 more than 3 consecutive 2-year periods, in accordance
2 with subsections (b) and (c).

3 (b) CONDITIONS.—An extension may be granted
4 under subsection (a) only in accordance with—

5 (1) the good faith, due diligence, and public in-
6 terest requirements contained in section 13 of the
7 Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806); and

8 (2) the procedures of the Commission under
9 such section.

10 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This section shall take effect
11 for FERC Project No. 3943 upon the expiration of the
12 extension of the period required for commencement of con-
13 struction of such project issued by the Commission under
14 section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806).

15 **SEC. 2. PROJECT NUMBER 3944.**

16 (a) EXTENSION.—Notwithstanding the time limita-
17 tions of section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C.
18 806), the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, upon
19 the request of the licensee for FERC Project No. 3944
20 (and after reasonable notice), may extend the time re-
21 quired for commencement of construction of such project
22 for not more than 3 consecutive 2-year periods, in accord-
23 ance with subsections (b) and (c).

24 (b) CONDITIONS.—An extension may be granted
25 under subsection (a) only in accordance with—

1 (1) the good faith, due diligence, and public in-
2 terest requirements contained in section 13 of the
3 Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806); and

4 (2) the procedures of the Commission under
5 such section.

6 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This section shall take effect
7 for FERC Project No. 3944 upon the expiration of the
8 extension of the period required for commencement of con-
9 struction of such project issued by the Commission under
10 section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806).

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
